The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against Nicolae Boldizsar, 27 years old, son of Nicolaea and Sofia nee' Ciuran born in Romania on the 14th February, 1988 and residing at Charlie's Guest Housed, Msida, and holder of Romanian identity card number ZV 038125- CM[-41880214082207.

Being charged with having on the 20th June 2016 in San Gwann, Malta;

- 1. Committed theft of two mobile phones of make Samsung and Alcatel to the detriment of Matthew Duca, Telecom Ltd, and/or other unknown companies and/or unknown person/s, which theft is aggravated by value in terms of article 267,279 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;
- 2. Committed theft of a pair of glasses make Rayban, to the detriment of Solo Optical, and/or other unknown companies and/or unknown person's in terms of article 284 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

Thus whilst exhibiting the Conduct Certificate and a copy of his personal details, it is requested that this case be investigated according to Law.

Having heard the accused admit to the charges brought against him, and that he confirmed his guilty plea after the court gave him time to re consider his position.

Having heard final submissions.

Having seen the acts and documents of this case.

Considers:

The accused has admitted to the charges and thus these have been sufficiently proven.

As for the punishment to be meted out, the Court is taking into consideration the nature and seriousness of the crime and the fact that the stolen tiems have been returned.

The court, after having seen articles 261 (c), 267, 279 (c), 284 and 285 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, upon admission finds the accused giulty of the charges brought agianst him and condemns him to 15 months inmprisonment which by appplication of article 28A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta are bieng suspended for a period of 3 years.

The Court has explained to the accused the consequencs if h commits an offence within the operative period of this judgment.
