The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against:

Kajetan Karol Poznanski of 26 years, son of Krzysztof and Anna nee' Wodarska, born in Poznan, Poland on the 6th October, 1989, has no fixed address in Malta and holder of Polish ID card number ASA740452.

And charge him with having on the 17th February, 2016 in these islands, in order to gain any advantage or benefit for himself or others, knowingly made a false declaration or statement, or gave false information;

Furthermore, for having on the same day and/or the previous days in these islands, carried outside any premises or appurtenance thereof, a knife or cutting or pointed instrument for which the acquisition, possession for whatever purpose, keeping or importation is prohibited, without a licence or permit from the Commissioner.

The Court;

Having seen all documents exhibited in these proceedings.

Having heard his guilty plea.

Having seen Article 188 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, Article 3, 6 and Schedule I (Article 3) of Chapter 480 of the Laws of Malta.

Having considered the fact that the accused co-operated with the Prosecution and admitting to the charges in the early stages of these proceedings;

The Court thus finds him guilty of the accusations and condemns him to a period of imprisonment of three months suspended for two years.
