The Court,

Having seen that the accused Joseph Paul Fagan, holder of Passport Number

PC1516051.

Was charged with having:

On the 8<sup>th</sup> of January 2017, at around 01:30 a.m. at the Bella Vista Hotel in St Paul's Bay, without the intent to kill or to put the life of Patrick Hughes in manifest jeopardy caused the mentioned grievous bodily harm in breach of Articles 216 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

And of having on the same date, place, time and circumstances willfully disturbed the public good order or the public peace in breach of Article 338(dd) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta; and

Of having on the same date, time, place and circumstances, of having been in any public place or place open to the public, drunk and incapable of taking care of himself in breach of Article 338(ff) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Heard guilty plea by the accused to the charges brought against him and the

confirmation of such plea after being the opportunity to reconsider his plea;

Having heard by the prosecution that accused co-operated fully with prosecution; and

After seen Articles 216, 338(dd) and 338(ff) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, finds accused Joseph Paul Fagan guilty of all the charges brought against him and by virtue of Article 28A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta condemns him to one (1) year imprisonment suspended for two (2) years.

Finally explained in simple words to the accused, the repercussions if such order is not complied with.
