Today, the 13th of April, 2017

The Court,

Having seen that the accused Paul Steve, holder of Police Number 13W-071.

Was charged with having:

On the 12th of April 2017, at around 23:30hrs, with intent to commit the crime of aggravated theft from 'Providence Flats' Flat no 5, situated at Gifen Street in St Paul's Bay, manifested such intent by overt acts which followed the commencement of the execution of the crime, in breach of Articles 41(1)(a), 263, 269 and 270 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Heard guilty plea by the accused to the charge brought against him and the confirmation of such plea after being given the opportunity to reconsider his position, and that he co-operated with prosecution;

And after seeing Articles 41(1)(a), 263, 269 and 270 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, finds accused Paul Steve guilty of the charge brought against him

and by virtue of Article 28A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta condemns him to two (2) years imprisonment suspended for four (4) years.

Finally, explained in the simple words to the accused, the repercussions is such order is not complied with.
