The Court;

After seeing the charges brought against Oleksandr Polyakov 29 years, son of Yuriy and Ludmilla Polyakov, born in Ukraine, on the 4th of February 1988, residing at Blk 10, Flat 2, La Vallette Street, Birgu and holder of a Maltese ID card: 154683(A);

With having on the 20th March 2017 at around 1:00hrs while at the Birgu Waterfront, Birgu and/ or in the Maltese Islands.

- 1) Wilfully committed any spoil, damage or injury to or upon any movable or immovable property that is a vehicle of make BMW with registration number plate X2 REP belonging to a certain Martin Robert Bury which amount of damage does not exceed two thousand and five hundred euro (2,500) but exceeds two hundred and fifty euro (250);
- 2) On the same date, time, place and circumstances in any public place or place open to the public found drunk and incapable of taking care of himself;

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charges brought against him, notwithstanding the fact that the Court warned him in the most solemn manner of

legal consequences of his guilty plea after giving him sufficient time within which to reconsider and withdraw her guilty plea;

Having heard the prosecution and defence counsel make their submissions;

Having seen all the acts and documents exhibited;

Considers;

After having seen Articles 325(1)(b) u 338(ff) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

After having heard the evidence and the documents exhibited;

On admission the Court finds the said accused guilty and is discharging him subject to the condition that he does not commit another offence for a period of one (1) year, in terms of Article 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta.

The Court explained in clear words the terms of the judgment to the accused.
