The Court;

After seeing the charges brought against Bakary Tarwalleh, 29 years, Guinea National, born on the 15th December 1988 in Guinea Bissau, residing at Hal Far, Hangar Open Centre, Birzebbugia, holder of Police no: 14C-084;

With having on the 21st May 2017 and in the previous days in Malta:

- 1) While having in his possession a document issued by a competent authority, that is an Italian passport, issued in the name of Camaro Chekhou, had transferred this document to another person or received this document which was transferred to him by another person;
- 2) And charged also with having on the same date, time and circumstances made use or attempted to make use of passport, issued to another person, that is the mentioned document;

3) And charged also with having on the same date, time and circumstances made false return, false statement or false representation to the Principal Immigration Officer;

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charges brought against him, notwithstanding the fact that the Court warned him in the most solemn manner of legal consequences of his guilty plea after giving him sufficient time within which to reconsider and withdraw his guilty plea;

Having heard the prosecution and defence counsel make their submissions;

Having seen all the acts and documents exhibited;

Considers;

After having seen Articles 3 and 4 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta, and Article 32(1)(c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta;

The Court finds the said accused guilty and is charging him with six (6) months imprisonment suspended for two (2) years in terms of Article 28A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.
