Bojana Tonic

The Court,

Having seen the charges against Bojana Tonic and holder of Serbian Passport Number 010298643.

Charged with having on the 14th of Febraury, 2018 or previous days, in order to gain any advantage or benefit for herself or others, in any document intended for any public authority, knowingly made a false declaration or statement or gave false information to the Airport Police (Chapter 9, sec 188);

And also charged with having on same date circumstances, made or caused to be made any false return, false sattement or false representation in relation to any information to be given under or for purposes of the Immigration Act [(Chapter 217, Sec 32 (1)(c)]

Having heard defendant admit the charges brought against her.

Having seen the acts of the proceedings.

Having heard the submissions regarding the penalty to be meted out.

Having considered

The defendant admitted the charges brought against her; these are consequently sufficiently proved.

With regards the penalty to be meted out the Court took into consideration the nature of the charges brought against defendant on the one hand, and on the other hand defendant's co-operation with the police and her admission at the ealiest stage of the proceedings.

Wherefore, the Court after having seen section 188 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta and section 32(1)(c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta, on her admission finds defendant guilty of the charges broought against her and condemns her to one year imprisonment which by application of section 28A of the said Chapter 9 is being suspended for a period of three years.

The Court explained to the defendant in ordinary language the significance of this judgement and of the consequences should she commit an other offence in the period of 3 years.
