Anton Svedin

The Court;

After seeing the charges brought against Anton Svedin of 27 years, son of Dick and Lena nee' Haggstrom, born in Sweden on the 1st of May 1991, residing at Room No. 768, St. George's Park, Draguna Road, St. Julian's and holder of unknown Swedish Identity Card no:- 72245597;

Charged with having on the 2nd May 2018 at around 4:15hrs in St. Rita Steps, Paceville, St. Julian's;

- 1) Assaulted or resisted by violence or active force not amounting to public violence, any person lawfully charged with a public duty when in the execution of the law or of a lawful order issued by a competent authority;

- 2) Caused slight injuries to PC 1387 Owen Mifsud as certified by Dr. Neville Borg M.D. Med. Reg. No. 3669;
- 3) Reviled, or threatened, or cause a bodily harm to any person lawfully charged with a public duty, while in the act of discharging his duty or because of his having discharged such duty, or with intent to intimidate or unduly influence him in the discharge of such duty;
- 4) In any public place or place open to the public, is found drunk and incapable of taking care of himself;
- 5) In any manner wilfully disturbed the public good order or the public peace;
- 6) Disobeyed the lawful orders of any authority or of any person entrusted with a public service , or hinders or obstructs such person in the exercise of his duties, or otherwise unduly interferes with the exercise of such duties, either by preventing other persons from doing what they are lawfully enjoined or allowed to do, or frustrating or undiong what has been lawfully done by other persons, or in any other manner.

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charges brought against him, notwithstanding the fact that the Court warned him in the most solemn manner of legal consequences of his guilty plea after giving him sufficient time within which to reconsider and withdraw her guilty plea;

Having heard the prosecution and defence counsel make their submissions;

Having seen all the acts and documents exhibited;

Considers:

After having seen the Articles 95, 96, 221, 338(dd), 338(ee) and 338(ff) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

After having heard the accuser's plea and after having given the time prescribed by Law for the accused to consider his plea, this Court finds the said accused guilty as charged and condemns to a fine (multa) of four thousand Euro (€4,000).

Discharges him from further punishment on condition that he does not commit another offence for a period of two (2) years.

The Court explained in clear words the terms of the judgement to the accused.
