**Dean Robert**

The Court,

Having seen the charges against Dean Robert, and holder of UK Passport Number 54231713.

Charged with having on a Thomas Cook aircraft MT 1146 on the 19th of July, 2018 between 16:00hrs and 18:00hrs;

- a. Recklessly or negligently acted in a manner likely to endanger an aircraft, or any person therein;
- b. Recklessly or negligently with the performance by a member of the crew of the aircraft of his duties;
- c. Intentionally interfered with the performance by a member of the crew of the aircraft of his duties;
- d. Behaved in a threatening, abusive, insulting or disorderly manner towards a member of the crew of the aircraft;
- e. Entered any aircraft when drunk, or be drunk in any aircraft;

- f. Wilfully disturbed the public good order or the public peace;
- g. With having on the same date, time, place and circumstances, having disobeyed the lawful orders of any authority or of any person entrusted with a public service PS 1312 Hadrian Sultana and PS 1449 David Parnis, or hindered or obstructed such person in the exercise of his duties; and
- h. With having on the same date, time and place and circumstances, wilfully disturbed the public good order or the public peace.

Having heard defendant admit the charges brought against him.

Having seen the acts of the proceedings.

Having heard the submissions regarding the penalty to be meted out.

Having considered

The defendant admitted the charges brought against him; these are consequently sufficiently proved.

With regards the penalty to be meted out the Court took into consideration the nature of the charges brought against defendant on the one hand, and on the other hand defendant's co-operation with the police and his admission at the earliest stage of the proceedings as well as his clean conviction sheet.

Wherefore, the Court after having seen section 338(dd)(ee) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta and regulations 46, 48(b)(c) and 49(1) of Legal Notice 176 of the year 1990 (SL499.09), on his admission finds defendant guilty of the charges brought against him and condemns him to a fine of one thousand five hundred and forty five Euro (€1,545.00).
