The Court,

Having seen that the accused Nicholas Marie Joseph Lejeune, ID 0178218(A) was charged with having:

- (1) On the 25th March 2018 between 11.10hrs and 11.21 hrs at Homemate Ltd in 3rd September 1798 Str B' Kara l/o Qormi committed simple theft of power bank with value of € 39.40 and 1 usb cable with value of € 4.70 for the detriment of Homemate Ltd;
- (2) On the 8th April 2018 at around 12.10 hrs from the same store committed simple theft of one power bank with the value of \notin 39.40 for the detriment of Homemate.

After having seen all documentation and heard the testimony of Khalid Abugrin.

After having seen Article 284 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Upon admission of the charges by the accused and the confirmation of such charges after given the opportunity to reconsider his position, finds accused

Nicholas Marie Joseph Lejeune guilty of all the charges brought against him, and upon application of Article 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta, frees him on condition that he does not commit another offence within one (1) year.

Finally explained to the accused in simple words, the repercussions if such order is not complied with.
