**Bojan Bozic**

The Court;

Having seen the charges brought against Bojan Bozic 34 years old, son of Bojko and Bjanka nee Negovanovic, born in Sremska Mitrovica Serbia on the 31<sup>st</sup> of December, 1983, residing at number 4 Church Street St Paul's Bay and holder of Serbian Passport number 012851378

Accused with having on the 11<sup>th</sup> of August, 2017 in St Paul's Bay, committed theft to the detriment of Andre Zahra and Emanuel Camilleri, which theft is aggravated by the nature of the thing stolen.

Having seen all records of the proceedings.

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charge brought against him, notwithstanding the fact that the Court warned him of the consequences of his guilty plea after having afforded him sufficient time within which to withdraw his guilty plea, the Court has no alternative but to find him guilty of the charge brought against him.

With regards to punishment the Court took into consideration the fact that the accused filed a guilty plea at such an early stage of the proceedings and the fact that he co-operated with the police during the course of the investigation as well as the fact that he has a clean criminal record.

For the above mentioned reasons and after having seen sections 260, 271 and 281 of the Criminal Code the Court finds the accused guilty of the charge brought against him and condemns him to eighteen (18) months imprisonment which in terms of Section 28A of the Criminal Code are being suspended for a period of two (2) years from today.
