The Court;

Having seen the joint application dated 29<sup>th</sup> October 2021, the parties under oath submit and confirmed;

1. That the parties were married in the 8<sup>th</sup> November 2013 and this is evidenced by their marriage certificate here annexed and marked and Doc. MA 1;
2. That the parties dissolved and liquated the communion of acquests between them and affected the personal separation by means of a personal separation contract published in deeds of Notary Ayrton Buhagiar, on the 11<sup>th</sup> December 2018 here annexed and marked as Doc MA 2;
3. That from this marriage the parties have one child Jams Falzon born on the 4<sup>th</sup> February 2015;
4. That the parties have been de facto separated since May 2018 as is evidenced and stated in Clause C of the separation contracted referred to above;
5. That the applicants stated that no maintenance is due and therefore no reciprocal maintenance claims;
6. That there is no reasonable prospect of reconciliation between them given that today they have a life totally separated from each other;
7. That these mentioned facts, satisfy all the necessary conditions for obtaining a divorce according to Article 66 B of the Civil Code, Cap. 16 of the Laws of Malta;

The applicants therefore humbly request this Honorable Court to;

1. Pronounces the dissolution of the marriage between the parties;
2. Order the Registrar of Courts to, within the time allowed by Court, notify the Director of the Public Registrar of the dissolution of the marriage (divorce) between the parties so that it be registered in the Public Registry.

**DECIDE:**

Now, therefore, the Court;

Upholds the parties' claim.

Declares the divorce of the marriage contracted between the parties  
on the **8<sup>th</sup> November 2013**.

Orders the Registrar of Courts to inform within ten (10) days the  
Director of the Public Registry to register the divorce in the Public  
Registry.

Without costs.

Term for leave to appeal abbreviated to one day.
