The Court;

Having seen Application of NA S and LH as duly represented by Doctor of Laws Dr. Rodianne Sciberras (I.D. 376688M) dated 14th March 2023;

They respectfully submit and on oath confirm:

- That the parties entered into marriage on the 22nd of February 2006 [vide Dok A] and from this marriage two sons were born, LJ born on 27th of December 2008 and LL born on the 3rd of February 2015;
- That the parties legally separated by means of a contract of separation duly authorised by the Family Court, on the 14th of February 2023 in the acts of Notary Doctor Ann Marie Agius [Dok B];
- 3. That there is no reasonable prospect of reconciliation between the parties since today they both lead separate lives;
- 4. That in accordance with clause two [2] of the separation contract, the parties have renounced in a definite manner from their right to demand maintenance from one another;
- 5. That, there are no arrears with regards the maintenance of the minor children;
- That these above indicated facts satisfy all the necessary requisites for obtaining a divorce according to Article 66B of the Civil Code, Chapter 16, of the Laws of Malta;

Therefore, this Honourable Court is being requested to:

- 1. Pronounce the dissolution of the marriage between the parties;
- 2. Orders the Registrar of Courts so that within the given period by the Court, informs the Director of the Public Registry with the dissolution of the marriage of the parties and for the same to be registered in the Public Registry.

DECIDE:

Now, therefore, the Court; Upholds the applicants' claim.

Declares the divorce of the marriage contracted between the parties on the 22^{nd} February 2006.

Orders the Registrar of Courts to inform within ten (10) days the Director of the Public Registry to register the divorce in the Public Registry.

Without costs.
