The Court;

Having seen the Conjoint application of KJ , and C L M Q , dated 30th November 2023;

Respectfully submit:

That the parties contracted their marriage in South Africa on the tenth (10th) February of the year two thousand twenty-two (2022), which marriage was registered in South Africa, as results from the marriage certificate bearing registration reference letter íHi numbers one ó zero ó nine ó nine ó eight ó seven ó one (H1099871), a copy of which is hereby being annexed and marked as **Doc A**.

That the parties separated on the twenty eighth (28th) day of August of the year two thousand and twenty-three (2023) as results from the separation contract in the acts of Notary Doctor Sylvana Borg Caruana, a copy of which is hereby being annexed and marked as **Doc B**.

That there is no reasonable prospect for reconciliation between the parties they both lead separate lives from one another.

That these facts satisfy all the conditions required by law to obtain a divorce in terms of Article 66B of The Civil Code, Chapter 16 of the Laws of Malta.

That, therefore, in view of the above, the applicants humbly request this Honourable Court:

1. To pronounce the dissolution of the marriage between the parties;

2. To order the Registrar of Courts such that within a time established for this purpose by the Court, to notify the Director of Public Registry with the dissolution of this marriage so that this is registered in the Maltese Public Registry.

Having seen that the Court could pass judgment on the evidence submitted with the application.

DECIDE:

Now, therefore, the Court;

Upholds the applicants' claim.

Declares the divorce of the marriage contracted between the parties on the **10th February 2022**.

Orders the Registrar of Courts to inform within ten (10) days the Director of the Public Registry to register the divorce in the Public Registry.

Without costs.

Term for leave to appeal abbreviated to one day.
