The Court;

Seen charges against the accused Rheo Victoriano Loberiza, holder of Philippine passport number P9257548A:

And charge him with having on the 21st April 2024 and in the previous months and years, on these islands and/or at Point Avenue Court, Block B, Flat 23, Tower Road, Msida, by several acts committed by him, even if at different times, which constitute violations of the same provision of the law, committed in pursuance of the same design:

As a person in Malta, has made or produced or permitted to be made or produced any indecent material involving or showing persons under age or produced, distributed or disseminated, imported, exported, offered, sold, supplied, transmitted, made available, procured for oneself or for another, or showed such indecent material which is extreme of persons under age who have not completed the age of nine years or where the indecent material shows, depicts or represents a minor involved in acts of bestiality, brutality, sadism or torture.

Art 208A, (1)(3) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

And also, on the same date, time, place and circumstances, acquired, knowingly obtained through information and

communication technologies to, or is possession of, any indecent material which shows, depicts or represents a person under age. Art 208A, (1B) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

The Court was finally being requested, in pronouncing judgment or in any subsequent order, sentence the person convicted to pay the costs incurred in connection with any experts or referee and this in accordance to Article 533 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Heard a guilty plea by the accused for the charges brought against him, which such plea was confirmed in today's sitting after being given the opportunity to reconsider his plea.

The Court, after seeing Article 208A(1)(3)(1B) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta finds the accused **Rheo Victoriano Loberiza** guilty of the charges brought against him and condemns him to a punishment of two (2) years imprisonment together with a Treatment Order under Article 412 Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta for a period for three (3) years and which order shall form an integral part with this sentence.

The Court is also ordering that the name of accused be put in the registry of sex offenders found under Chapter 518 of the Laws of Malta.

Finally, explained in simple words the repercussions if such order is not complied with.
