**The Court;**

Having seen the Application of the parties;

Humbly states:

- 1) That parties contracted marriage in Malta on the 8 August 2018 and of this marriage no children were born (DOK A)
- 2) That they separated by means of contract of separation published on the 11 March 2024 in the acts of notary Francesca Cachia Zammit (Doc. B)
- 3) The parties live separately and there has been no reunions between them since;
- 4) That maintenance due by defendant for the needs of the minor child have been paid and there are no arrears;
- 5) That there is no reasonable prospect of reconciliation between the parties
- 6) That therefore the conditions envisaged in section 66B of Chapter 16 of The Laws of Malta are satisfied and in light of the fact that the parties are separated by means of contract of separation no mediation is required
- 7) That parties are attaching their affidavits in Maltese (doc. C1- C2 ) and in English (DOK D1- D2)

FOR these reason applicants requested with respect on the basis of Section 66B of Chapter 16 of The Laws of Malta that this Honorable Court deem it save any hearing that necessary on the basis of section of Section 66B of Chapter 16 of The Laws of Malta in order to ascertain the existence of the satisfaction of the

conditions outlined in section 66B pronounced divorce between the parties as envisaged in section 66C

**DECIDE:**

Now, therefore, the Court;

Upholds the applicants' claim.

Declares the divorce of the marriage contracted between the parties on the **8<sup>th</sup> August 2018;**

Orders the Registrar of Courts to inform within ten (10) days the Director of the Public Registry to register the divorce in the Public Registry.

Without costs.

Term for leave to appeal abbreviated to one day.
