The Court

Having seen the charges against Efunbowale Adeola Johnson Sixtythree years old (63), daughter of Babatunde and Hilda nee` Cocker born in Liverpool on 29/09/1961 and 77 Wroughton Road London SW11 6AS UK, British Passport 127444966.

Accusing her that on the 13^{th of} November 2024 of the year two thousand and twenty-four (2024), in Imdina Road, Attard in Maltese Islands, by various acts made by her, which violates the provisions of the Maltese Law;

1. Charged, by recklessness or lack of responsibility in your art or profession, or by failure to comply with regulations, you have inflicted a serious (grievous) offence on the person of John Cauchi, without the consequences mentioned in article 218 of the Criminal Code (and that is to have had the consequences mentioned under the Article 216 of the Criminal Code of Laws of Malta), Article 226(1)(b), chapter 9 of Laws of Malta.

2. And also, for committing same date, time and circumstances, drove the vehicle registration number CQZ321, in a reckless, negligent or dangerous manner, in terms of, Article 15(1)(a) of Chapter 9 of Laws of Malta.

The Court is also being humbly requested that in the case of guilt, in addition to the punishment in accordance to law, orders the accused to pay the costs incurred in connection to the appointment of any experts in terms of Article 533 of the Criminal Code, Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen articles 226(1)(b) of Chap 9 Article 15(1)(a) of Chap 65 of the Laws of Malta

Having seen the admission of guilt registered by the accused in the initial stages of the proceedings

Considerations of the Court

The accused registered an admission of guilt in the initial stages of the proceedings.

Decide

For these reasons and after having seen Articles 226(1) (b) of Chap 9 and article 15(1)(a) of Chap 65 of the laws of Malta finds Efunbowale Adeola Johnson guilty of the charges and conditionally discharges her for the period of one(1) year.
