The Court;

Having seen the joint application of MDDV and CCD

Respectfully submit and confirm under oath the following:

1. That the plaintiffs got married in Romania on 11th April 2014 extract of the marriage annexed and marked **Dok A** and settled in Malta on 15 August 2015;
2. That from this marriage the plaintiffs did not have any children;
3. That the plaintiffs de facto separated on 11 December 2016 and subsequently separated de jure by means of contract dated 9 May 2024 In the acts of Notary Marilena Cristina annexed and marked **Dok B**;
4. That the plaintiffs have been living completely independent lives from each other from 11 December 2016 and there is no prospect of reconciliation between them;
5. That moreover there is no maintenance due given that the plaintiffs forfeited the right to receive maintenance from each other in the separation agreement;
6. That the plaintiffs want to divorce and agree that their marriage is to be dissolved ;
7. That in the light of Aforementioned facts the plaintiffs satisfy the requirements imposed by article 66B of the Civil Code (chapter 16 of the laws of Malta) to ask that their marriage be dissolved;

Therefore the plaintiffs humbly request that this Honorable Court after given any declaration and order it deems appropriate and opportune:

1. Orders the dissolution of the marriage contracted by the plaintiffs on 11 April 2014 in Romania and;
2. Orders the registrar of Court to inform the Director of the time fixed by the Court , of the divorce of the plaintiffs so that the said divorce can be registered in the Public Registry.

DECIDE:

Now, therefore, the Court;

Upholds the applicants' claim.

Declares the divorce of the marriage contracted between the parties on the 11th April 2014

Orders the Registrar of Courts to inform within ten (10) days the Director of the Public Registry to register the divorce in the Public Registry.

Without costs.
