The Court;

Having seen the application of SZ dated 31 January 2025;

She humbly submits:

1. That on the 30th January 2025 the parties appeared on a deed of personal separation in acts of Notary Maria Roberta Galea Mamo (copy herewith attached and marked as Document 'A');
2. That following the signing of the separation contract, plaintiff is hereby withdrawing her, second, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth demands as put forward in her sworn application;
3. That as agreed in clause twenty-one (21) of the separation contract, the plaintiff is hereby requesting that her first demand be converted to a demand for divorce in terms of Article 66F of the Civil Code of Malta;

For these reasons, applicant humbly ask that this Honorable Court converts her first demand for personal separation to a request for divorce from respondent in terms of Article 66F of Chapter 16 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen that this request was agreed to by respondent;

Having seen the rest of the acts of these proceedings;

Having seen a copy of the agreement reached by the parties;

CONSIDERS:

That the parties had entered into a contract of separation, dated 30 January 2025, following a sworn application filed by plaintiff on the 14 October 2024 requesting personal separation from defendant. During the hearing of the case, the parties arrived at an amicable agreement, which was approved by this Court. Subsequently, the application was converted into a divorce application after a request to this effect was filed by plaintiff and upheld by the Court. Since defendant is not objecting to the granting of the divorce, the Court shall uphold the request.

DECIDE:

Now, therefore, the Court;
Upholds the applicants' claim.

Declares the divorce of the marriage contracted between the parties on the **6th June 2021**

Orders the Registrar of Courts to inform within ten (10) days the Director of the Public Registry to register the divorce in the Public Registry.

Without costs.
