Having seen the application of JV ET

The applicants humbly submit as follows:

WHEREAS the parties contracted marriage on the 4th of February 2006 and no children were born from said marriage; a marriage certificate is hereby annexed and marked as **Doc A**;

WHEREAS the parties separated legally on the 20th of February 2025 by virtue of a separation agreement, which is likewise hereby annexed and marked as **Doc B**;

WHEREAS the parties have renounced their right to claim and receive maintenance from each other;

WHEREAS there is no reasonable prospect of reconciliation and both parties lead separate lives;

WHEREAS the aforementioned satisfy the conditions required by Law for the granting of a divorce in terms of Article 66B of Chapter 16 of the Laws of Malta.

THEREFORE, the applicants humbly request this Honourable Court to:

1. Pronounce divorce between the parties in accordance with Article 66B of Chapter 16 of the Laws of Malta;
2. Order the Registrar of Courts, within a period that this Honourable Court may deem appropriate, to inform the Director of the Public Registry of the divorce between the parties so that the said decree may be duly registered.

Together with any other order that this Honourable Court may deem fit and appropriate.

DECIDE:

Now, therefore, the Court;

Upholds the applicants' claim.

Declares the divorce of the marriage contracted between the parties on the **4th February 2006**

Orders the Registrar of Courts to inform within ten (10) days the Director of the Public Registry to register the divorce in the Public Registry.

Without costs.

Term for leave to appeal abbreviated to one day.
