The Court,
Having seen the charges profferred against the accused
with having on the 22nd September, 2002 at about 5.00
p.m. in Triq il-Villeíjatura, St. Paul's Bay –
1. wilfully disturbed the public good order and the public
peace;
2. without intent to kill or to put the life of John Borg in
manifest jeopardy, caused injuries of a grievous nature on
the person of John Borg.

Kopja Informali ta' Sentenza

The Court has been requested that in case that the accused is found guilty, in addition to, or in lieu of the punishment applicable to the offence, to provide for the safety of John Borg.

Having seen the note filed by the Attorney General whereby he gave his assent that this case be tried summarily.

Having seen the records of the case of the 12th February, 2003 where the Court was informed that the injuries suffered by John Borg were of a slight nature.

Having seen the undertaking given by the accused that he will not talk to or molest John Borg, the said John Borg withdrew his complaint.

Having seen that the prosecution had no further evidence to produce.

Consequently, the Court does not find guilty the accused of the first charge proffered against him and so sets him free. With regard to the second charge the Court declares the proceedings brought against the accused as withdrawn.
