The Court,

Having seen the charges against the said Graham Okeremute Unah of 28 years, a Nigerian national, son of Tom, born at Lagos on the 23<sup>rd</sup> August 1973 and holder of passport number C 369655;

With having during the months and weeks preceding his arraignment under arrest on 13<sup>th</sup> November 2001, without having been granted a residence permit, landed or was in Malta without leave from the Principal Immigration Officer. Having seen that accused pleaded guilty .

Therefore whilst finding the accused guilty discharges him subject to the condition that he commits no offence during the period of three (3) months which starts running from today.

The Court is explaining to the guilty party in ordinary language that if he commits another offence during the period of conditional discharge he will be liable to be sentenced for the original offence.

Having seen the prosecution's request in terms of section 14 of Chapter 217 dismisses the request since accused has married a Maltese Citizen.
