The Court,

Having seen the charges against the accused Alisa Stevanociv 25 years, daughter of Zoran and Azira nee' Hrnjice, born in Yogoslavia on 6th October 1976 and residing at No. 14 Louise Flats/1, Naxxar Road San Gwann, holder of ID No. 343801L charged:

1. for having on 19 November 2001 at about 5.45p.m. in St. Julians, assaulted or resisted by violence or active force, not amounting to public violence, WPC-162 Graziella Callus, a person lawfully charged with a public

duty when in execution of the law or of a lawful order issued by a competent authority, in breech of Sec. 96(a) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

- 2. on the same date, time and circumstances, reviled or threatened or caused a bodily harm to WPC-162 Graziella Callus, a person lawfully charged with a public duty, while in the act of discharging her duty or because of her having discharged such duty, or with intent to intimidate or unduly influence her in the discharge of such duty, in breech of Section 95 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;
- 3. on the same date, time, place and circumstances, caused slight bodily harm on the person of WPC-162 Graziella Callus as certified by Dr. Anton Bugeja M.D. of the Floriana Health Centre, in breech of Sec. 221 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charges.

Having heard complainant.

Having seen all the records.

Considers:

Accused had persisted in her plea of guilty to the charges adduced against her although given time to reconsider.

On the strength o the charges and having considered Articles 95, 221 and 17 of Chapter 9 and complaint's waiver decides to acquit the accused unconditionally by application of Article 22 of Chapter 446.
