The Police (Inspector Joseph Mercçca) vs Juan Antonio Saugar Branch, son of Angel, born in Spain on the 25<sup>th</sup> March, 1969

The Court,

Having seen the charge profferred against the accused, as a person in charge of operations of the Ramla Bay Hotel, Ramla tal-Bir, limits of Mellçóa, on the 10<sup>th</sup> November, 2003 and\or during the previous months, by several acts committed by the accused, even at different times, and which constitute violations of the same provisions of the law, and which were committed in pursuance of the same design, took in his employment, or has given work to John Savage, who is not an exempt Informal Copy of Judgement

person and is not in possession of a licence granted to him for the purpose of such employment or work under the provisions of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen the note filed by the Attorney General whereby he gave his consent for this case to be heard summarily.

Having seen the records of the case of the sitting of the 11<sup>th</sup> November, 2003 where the accused admitted to the charge as profferred.

Having heard the counsel for the defence and the prosecuting officers.

Consequently, the Court finds the accused guilty of the charge as profferred. Having seen section 32(1)(b) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta condems him to the payment of a fine of one hundred Malta Liri (Lm100).
