The Court

Having seen the accusation brought against Stanislav Nikitin, 18 years of age, son of late Igor and Tatyana, born in Moscow, on the 30th July, 1985, residing no. 19, Berzarina Street, Moscow, Russia, holder of Russian passport 51 no. 0354236, and charge himon 1st August, 2003, at about 7.45p.m., at the Qawra Palace Hotel, in Qawra road, Qawra, Informal Copy of Judgement

Had in your possession the resin obtaoned from the Plant Cannabis, or any other preparation of which such resin formed part, in terms of Section 8 (a) of the Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta.

Wilfully disturbed the public good order and/or the public peace (Section 338 (dd) of Chapter 9,

In a public place, you exposed yourself naked (Section 338 (q)of Chapter 9) and

Wilfully committed spoil to the police uniform ov PC 914 Ivan Mifsud, which danages does not exceed ten Maltese Liri (Lm10) to the detriment of the Government of Malta.

Having heard the plea of guilt.

Find the accused guilty as charged.

Having seen articles 8 (a) Chapter 101, 338 (dd) (q) and 95 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

With the condition that he does not commit any other offence within a period of one year from today in term of articles 23 and 27 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta.

The Court orders the destruction of the drug and appoints Mr. Mario Mifsud for this aim.
