The Court;

Having seen the charges brought against Alex Ooms of 23 years born in Ammerstol Holland on the 10th February 1981 son of Otto and Marijke nee' De Jong, residing at Bergambacht Holand or Room 304, Dean Hamlet Hotel, Ross Street, St. Julians, Holder of Dutch ID number IB 5362461;

And against Remko Van Ineveld of 23 years, born in Roosendaal en Nispen on the 1st August 1980, son of Peter and Janny nee' De Feter residing at Visserjistraat 2 Ammerstol Holand or Rook 315 Dean Hamlet Hotel, Ross Street, St. Julians, Holder of Dutch ID T 66916271;

With having in these Islands, on the 14th July 2004 at about 6.35am in Elia Zammit Street, Paceville, St. Julians, and in the vicinity:

1. Wilfully committed any spoil damage or injury to or upon any immovable or movable property, that is to a public monument and/or garden to the detriment of St. Julian Local Council, the Government of Malta and other entities, which damages does not exceed Fifty Maltese Liri (Lm50) and this in breach of section 325 (1)(c) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

2. Disturbed the public peace and order, and this in breach of section 338 (dd) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

After having seen Sections 325 (1)(c), 338 (dd) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

Considers:

That having taken in consideration the plea of guilt at the early stages of these proceedings, this Court has no other alternative, but to find the said two accused guilty as charged and is acquitting them and conditionally discharging them for a period of ten (10) days, that is the Kopja Informali ta' Sentenza

period until they leave these Islands, in terms of Article 22 Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta.
