Having seen the charge against the said Nazim Ziad of 2i years of age, of Algerian Nationality, son of Aldo and Meriam; born on 21st April 1983 at Algeria and residing at 19, Lot Ben Haladi, Cherafu, Algeria and holder of passport with number 4778583.

Of having on the 19th August 2004 at about 02.30hrs at Paceville, St. Julians and during this same month was in possession of resin obtained from the plant Cannabis, or

any other preparation of which such resin formed the base, in terms of Section 8 (a) of the Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen that the accused pleade guilty.

Having seen that accused reiterated, after having been warned by the Court about the consequences of such plea, in the presence of defence counsel.

Finds accused guilty.

Havind seen Sec 8(a) of Chapter 101 and section 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta.

Tends to apply the lat mentioned section in view of the conduct sheet of the accused.

Therefore finds accused guilty and sets him free in terms of section 22 of

Chapter 446 provided that accused does not commit another crime within one (1) year from today. The Court is explaining in plain language the consequences of his committing another crime within the said period of one year.

The Court appoints pharmacist Mario Mifsud to destroy the exhibits.
