Vs Nadezhda Zlatvoka Stankova Iva Nicolova Zlatkova

The Court,
Having seen the charges against the accused Nadezhda Zlatvoka Stankova holder of passport number 332999117 and Iva Nicolova Zlatkova holder of passport number 334255965 with having:

On $12^{\text {th }}$ August, 2004 at around 10:30 in the morning, whilst in the Tower Supermarket situated in High Street

Sliema, tried to steal from the person of Rachel Helen Paul, which theft would have exceeded the sum of Lm 100 but not Lm 1000, and with the intent to commit a crime they have manifested such intent by overt acts which were followed by a commencement of the execution of the crime and such crime was not completed in consequence of some accidental cause independent of the will of the offenders.

Having seen the the Attorney General's consent that the case be heard sommarily;

Having heard the accused plea guilty to the charges adduced against them even after the court allowed them time to reconsider;

Having seen all the acts and records relating to the charges.

Considers:
On the basis of accuseds' admission to the charges which admission is voluntary and unconditional declairs the accused guilty of the charges proferred against them.

That such relate to an attempted theft from Tower Supermarket of High Street, Sliema.

Having considered articles 41, 261(c), 267, 279(a), 280 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta finds them guilty and acquits them conditionally that they do not commit another offence within three years from today by application of article 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta.
