The Court,

Having seen the charges against the accused Mapko Paic and Marco Novakovic both Yugoslav nationals and holders of passports number 003375537 and 004207320 respectively, with having:

On the 20th August, 2004 at around 5:30 p.m. at Ghadira Bay, Mellieha wilfully committed any spoil, damage or injury to or upon any movable property on a vehicle

bearing registration number KAL-983 of make Golf Mark 1 to the detriment of Albert Jones which damage exceeds Lm50 but not the sum of Lm 500.

Having seen Attorney General's consent that the case be heard sommarily.

Having heard the accused plea guilty to the charges adduced against them even after the court allowed them time to reconsider.

Having seen all the acts and records relating to the charges.

Considers:

That the accused have till now been detained in custody and have been so detained for the past 12 days.

That it has transpired to the court, confirmed by the prosecution, that the accused had retaliated to the theft of a bag which belonged and was stolen from one of the accused.

That considering the circumstances and having seen Article 325 of the Criminal code decides to acquit the accused conditionally that they don not commit another offence within 3 years from today by application of Article 22 of Chapter 446.
