VS

Ozgur Hazicioglu

The Court,

Having seen that Ozgur Hazicioglu, son of Abdurahman and Nermin, born in Istanbul on the 15th July 1975, holder of Turkish Passport No. 689813 and residing at the Drayton Court, Paceville.

Was charged that on the 27th September 2004, at around 10:00 in the morning he laid before the Executive Police an information regarding an offence knowing that such offence has not been committed, or has falsely devised the traces of an offence in such a manner that criminal

proceedings may be instituted for the ascertainment of such offence, and this according to article 110(2) of the Criminal Code Chap 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen that the accused pleaded guilty and repeated such plea after he was warned about the significance of such plea and its consequences, in the precence of his defense counsel.

Finds the accused guilty.

Having seen sections 110(2) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta and section 22 of Chapter 446, decides to apply the last mentioned section in view of the conduct sheet of the accused who co- operated with the Police and excused himself in Court.

Therefore the Court finds the accused guilty as above stated and discharges him subject to the condition that he commits no offence during the period of one (1) year running from today.
