The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against the accussed David Vautier 22 years, son of Michael and Catthy nee Schirra, born in France on the 26th March 1982 and serving on board French Navy Ship Duquesne berthed Valletta Port Id 040708300050 and Sebastian Camilleri 25 years son of Serge and Martina nee Breuille born in France on the 7th March 1979 and serving on board French Navy Ship Dequesne berthed Valletta Port ID 000992300838 and charged David Vautier alone that on the 9th October 2004, at about 23.30hours, in Paceville limit of St Julians, withoutr intent to kill or to put the life of

any person, that is the life of Luke Farrugia, in maniferst jeopardy, caused the mentioned Luke Farrugia harm to his body, which bodily harm is considered grievious, which caused any deformity or disfigurement in his face as certified by Dr A Agius of the Gzira Health Centre.

Sebsstian Camilleri charge alone with having on the same day, time place and circumstances, kept and carried an offensive instrument without a license from Commissioner of Police.

Both David Vautier and Sebatian Camilleri charged with having in the same date, time, place and circumstances, at night time, disturbed the repose of the inhabitants by cowdiness or bawling or in any other matter.

Having heard all the evidence.

Having seen all the documents exihibited.

Having seen the note in the record of the proceedings, where the accused admitted to the charges brought against them.

Having heard the oral submissions of both parties.

Deliberates:-

On their same admission the Court finds the accused guilty as charged, and after having seen. Art 216(b)(2), 338(dd) and 28A Chapter 9 and Art 2 and 3 of Chapter 66 condemns the accused Vautier a period of two years inprisonment suspended for four years, and Camilleri for a Lm60 fine.
