JAMES MUSCAT

The Court;

After having seen the imputations brought against James Muscat, aged 22 years, son of Dominic and Evelyn nee' Pace, born on the 28th of May, 1983, at Pieta', and residing at Flat 1, Soothay, Triq I-Iskall, Bahar ic-Caghaq, and Rue Augusto, Machado, no 13 R/C D Costa de Caprica, 2825 Portugal and bearer of Australian passport no L 8958989

Accused of having, on these island, on the night between the 3rd and 4th September, 2005, had in his possession psychotropic and restricted drugs (ecstasy) without a special authorization in writing by the Superintendent of Public Health, in breach of the provisions of the Medical and Kindred Professions Ordinance, Chapter 31 of the Laws of Malta and the Drugs Control Regulations, Legal Notice 22 of 1985, as amended.

After having heard the accused enter a guilty plead to the charges brought against him;

After having seen the provisions of Chapter 31 of the Laws of Malta and Legal Notice 22 of 1985;

After having seen the criminal record of the accused.

Finds the accused guilty as charged, and discharges him for a period of one (1) year, according to the provisions of Article 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta.
