FELIX STRICKER

The Court:

After having seen the charges brought agains Felix Stricker, aged 18 years, son of Thomas and Maja, born on the 29 of June, 1987 in Switzerland and residing at Paceville, bearer of Swiss ID card no 003796689;

Accused of having on these islands, on the night between the 13th and the 14th of October, 2005, had in his possession the resin obtained from the plant cannabis or any preparations of which such resin formed the base, in breach of Sec 8(a), Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta. After having seen the documents exhibited;

After having seen Articles 8(a) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta;

After having heard the accused admit to the accusations and confirmed such admission after having been given due time to reconsider his position according to Law;

After having heard the parties make their submissions as to the punishment to be awarded;

Considered:

The Court therefore finds the accused guilty as charged, and conditionally discharges him from any penalty on the understanding that he does not commit another offence for a period of six (6) months from today, according to Article 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta.

Moreover, the Court also orders the destruction of the substance seized by the Police and also orders the release of the passport of the accused.
