## The Court:

After having seen the charges brought against Andrew Brozko, aged 21 years, son of Jospeh and Halina, born on the 11 of May, 1984, in Australia, and residing at La Valette Hotel, Paceville, bearer of Australian passport number M3193436;

And Daniel Sant, aged 20 years, son of Joseph and Sylvana, born on the 16 of January, 1985 in Australia,
residing at Bidnija, and bearer of Australian passport number M2783595;

Accused of having, in these islands on the night between the $13^{\text {th }}$ and the $14^{\text {th }}$ of October, 2005, had in their possession the resin obtained from the plant cannabis or any preparations of which such resin formed the base, in breach of Sec 8 (a), Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta.

After having seen the documents exhibited;
After having seen Articles 8(a) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta;

After having heard the accused admit to the accusations and confirmed such admission after having been given due time to reconsider their position according to Law;

After having heard the parties make their submissions as to the punishment to be awarded;

## Considered:

The Court therefore finds the accused guilty as charged, and conditionally discharges them from any penalty on the understanding that they do not commit another offence for a period of six (6) months from today, according to Article 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta.

Moreover, the Court also orders the destruction of the substance seized by the Police and also orders the release of the passports of the accused.
