The Police (Inspector Daniel Zammit) vs Dasheva Yordanka Nikolaeva, daughter of Nicolai, born in Bulgaria on the 6th August, 1974 and Chokoeva Totka Nikolova, daughter of Nikola, born in Bulgaria on the 23rd June, 1969 and Dimcheva Elisaveta Ilieva, daughter of Dasheva Yordanka Nikolaeva, born in Bulgaria on the 15th August, 1993

The Court, Having seen the charge profferred against the accused namely, that on the 23rd May, 2005 at around 1400 hours,

in the Plaza Complex, Bisazza Street, Sliema, the accused tried to steal from the person of Mary Carmela Hili, holder of identity card number 221747, which theft would have exceeded Lm100 but not Lm1,000 and with intent to commit the crime they have manifested such intent by overt acts which were followed by a commencement of the execution of the crime and such crime was not completed in consequence of some accidental cause independent of the will of the offenders.

Having seen the records of the case of the 25th May, 2005 where the accused admitted to the charge as profferred.

Having heard defense counsel and the prosecution in regard to the punishment to be applied.

Consequently, the Court finds the accused guilty of the charge as profferred. Having seen sections 41, 261(c) and 279(a) of the Criminal Code. As regards Dimcheva Elisaveta Ilieva, on account of her age she is hereby admonished. As regards the other two accused they are hereby sentenced to one year imprisonment. However, having seen section 28A of the Criminal Code, the Court orders that such sentence does not come into effect unless the accused commit another offence within a period of four years which is punishable by imprisonment.
