The Court;

After having seen the charges broght against Kevin Akachukwu, aged 29 years, Nigerian national, son of Peter and Grace nee' Okereke, born at Enugu, Nigeria, on the 22 January, 1976, of no fixed address, and holder passport number A 2533657

Charged of having during the last months of Malta, in relation, to any information to be given under to be given under or for purposes of the Immigration Act, made or caused to be made any false return, false statement, or

false representation, in breach of Section 32(1)(c) Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta;

Also charged of having during the same time and circumstances, in Malta, made use or attempted to make use of a passport issued to any other person in breach of Section 4 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta.

After having seen Section 32(1)(c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta:

And also Section 4 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta.

Considered:

After having seen the documents exhibited;
After having heard the witnesses produced;
After having heard the accused admit to the charges brought against him and confirmed such admission after having been given due time to reconsider his position according to Law.

This Court therefore finds the said Kevin Akachukwu guilty as charged and condemns him to one (1) month imprisonment, suspended for one (1) year, according to Article 28 A, of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.
