

COURT OF MAGISTRATES (MALTA) AS A COURT OF CRIMINAL JUDICATURE

The Police (Insp Jeffrey Cilia) vs Musa Karademir, son of Veyis, born in Turkey on the 1st July, 1974

The Court,

Having seen the charges profferred against the accused – 1. that on the 23rd february, 2006 and during the days prior to this date, in Malta, forged altered or tempered with, or used or had in his possession a Bulgarian passport no. 326506336 which he knew to be forged altered or tempered with;

 on the same dates, time, place and circumstances in Malta, knowingly made use of forged documents;
on the same date, time, place and circumstances, as a

person who embarked or disembarked from Malta, made or caused to be made a false return, false statement or Informal Copy of Judgement

false representation and/or furnished the Principal Immigration Officer with false information.

Having seen the note filed by the Attorney General whereby he gave his consent that this case be tried summarily.

Having seen the records of the case of the 24th February, 2006 whereby the accused admitted to the charges as profferred.

Consequently, the Court finds him guilty of the charges as profferred. Having seen section 189 of the Criminal Code, section 5 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta and section 32(1)(c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta condemns the accused to a term of imprisonment of one year. Having seen section 28A of the Criminal Code orders that such punishment be not brought into effect unless the accused commits a further crime punishable with imprisonment for a period of one year from today.
