**The Court;**

After having seen the charges brought against Peter Ohaka, aged 24 years, son of Fidelis and Bernardette Onyewuenyi, born in Nigeria on the 31<sup>st</sup> of December, 1981 and residing at number 3, St Anthony Street, San Gwann, holder of identity card number 21407 A;

Accused of having on the 20<sup>th</sup> of March, 2006 at Sliema at about 12.00 noon:

Informal Copy of Judgement

- a) With lewd acts defiles minors Julie Risgaard Mortensen and Henriette Kihl, both 17 year old Danish subjects;
- b) And also of having during the same day, time and place committed an offence against decency or morals, by an act committed in public place or in a place exposed to the public;
- c) And also of having during the same day, time and place in the harbors on the shore, or in any other place exposed himself naked or indecently dressed;
- d) And finally of having during the same day, time and place committed a crime during the operative period of a suspended sentence delivered on the 11<sup>th</sup> of February, 2005 by the Courts of Magistrates (Malta).

After having seen Articles 203, 209, 338 (q), and 288 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

After having heard the accused admit to the accusations and confirmed such admission after having been given due time to reconsider his position according to Law;

The Court therefore finds the accused guilty as charged, and condemns him to three (3) months imprisonment;

Further more this same Court also renders operative the suspended sentence delivered on the 11<sup>th</sup> of February, 2005 by the Courts of Magistrates Malta, wherein the accused had been condemned to a period of imprisonment of three (3) months suspended for two (2) years.
