The Court,

Having seen the charge profferred against the accused that on the 4th May, 2006 at about 10.15 p.m. at Dragonara Road, St. Julians with intent attempted to commit aggaravated theft on the person of Maria Lourdes Galea, of 65 years, by violence, value and time, where such acts were manifested by overt acts followed by a commencement of the execution of the crime, where such crime was not completed in consequence of some accidental cause independent of the will of the offender.

Having seen the note filed by the Attorney General whereby he gave his consent that this case be dealt with summarily.

Having seen the records of the case of the 5th May, 2006 whereby the accused admitted to the charge as profferred.

Having heard the prosecution and defence counsel for the accused regarding punishment.

Consequently, the Court finds the accused guilty of the charge as proferred. Having seen sections 41, 261(a)(c)(f), 262, 267, 270, 276 and 277(a) of the Criminal Code. Having seen the young age of the accused, his clean record sheet and the fact that he admitted to the charge as profferred at the first hearingof this case. The Court does not condemn him to a period of imprisonment but sets him free under the conditions of section 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta on condition that he commits no other crime for a period of one year from today.
