The Court;
Saw the accusation brought forward against Sebastian Wanionek of 23 years, son of late John and late Bernardette nee' Szustkowska, born in Poland on the $17^{\text {th }}$ August, 1983, residing at 83, Flat 3, Manwel Dimech Street, Sliema and holder of passport number AK 3232617;

Charged with having on the night between the $18^{\text {th }}$ and $19^{\text {th }}$ July, 2006, in Manuel Dimech Street, Sliema you caused voluntary damage to vehicles Peugeot 306, colour greem, bearing registration number AAO-285 to the detriment of Arthur Camilleri from Sliema, Fiat Punto
colour Grey, bearing registration number JBC-183 to the detriment of Joseph Formosa from Sliema, Skoda Octavia colour blue, bearing registration number XIX-677 to the detriment of William Grech from Sliema, Rover 214 colour Green bearing registration number IBB-048 to the detriment of Peel Petra from Sliema and to vehicle Volkswagen Polo colour violet bearing registration number TNA-001 to the detriment of Martina Clara Vella of Sliema, which damage exceeds Lm50 but less than Lm500 in breach of article 325 (1)(b) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Having heard the plea of guilt;
Having seen the records of the case;
Find the accused guilty as charged;
Having seen the clean conduct sheet of the accused;
Having seen article 325 (b) Chapter 9of the Laws of Malta;

Discharges the accused with the condition that he does not commit any other offence within a period of two (2) years from today in terms of article 22 Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta.

The Court explained the obligations of the accused arising out of this judgement.
