## The Court;

After having seen the charges brought against Sasa Pavlovic, aged 32 years, son of Stanko and Nada nee' Mihajlovic, born in Belgrade Zemun Serbia on the $10^{\text {th }}$ of August, 1974, and temporarily residing in Malta at Mimmosa Flats, Flat 12, Triq Ross, St Julian's, holder of Yugoslav passport number 004059066;

Charged of having on the night between the $31^{\text {st }}$ July, 2006 and the $1^{\text {st }}$ of August, 2006 whilst at San Gwann, committed theft of several items from the premises of Nidda, situated at Triq il-Baltiku, which offence of theft is
aggravated by value in excess of one thousand maltese liri (Lm1,000.00), by place and by time.

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charges brought against him, after been given due time according to Law to reconsider his admission;

Having seen the documents exhibited;
Having seen Articles 261, 267, 269 u 270 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

## Considers:

This Court therefore finds the said accused guilty as charged, and therefore condemns him to a period of two (2) years imprisonment, suspended for four (4) years, in terms of Article 28 A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta; This Court also orders the accused the pay the sum of one thousand eight hundred maltese liri (Lm1,800.00) within six (6) months, which sum will cover damages suffered by Marquita Diacono, in terms of Article 28 H of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;
The Court orders furthermore that the passport of the accused be retained in these proceedings until the amount here above referred to will have been paid in full.
