

## COURT OF MAGISTRATES (MALTA) AS A COURT OF CRIMINAL JUDICATURE

The Police (Ins. Mario Haber) vs Udila Aurel

The Court;

Having seen the acusations brought against **Udila Aurel** of Romanian nationality, son of Danut and Marianna, born in Bucharest Romania on the 26<sup>th</sup> October, 1983 and holder of Romanian passport number RT402107;

With having on the 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2006 in Malta made use or attempted to make use of a passport issued to another person and this in violation of Article 4 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta;

Also with having on the 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2006 in Malta forged, altered or tampered with a passport or used or

had in his possession a passport which he knew to be forged, altered or tampered with, being passport of Czech Republic issued in the name of Olah Koloman bearing number 10467543 and this in violation of Article 5 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta

Also with having on the 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2006 and in the previous days in Malta while having in his possession a passport issued by a competent authority, had transferred this passport to another person or received a passport which was transferred to him by another person and this in violation of Article 6 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta.

Also with having on the 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2006 in Malta, knowingly made use of a forged documents being the above mentioned documents and this in violation of Article 189 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Also with having on the 27<sup>th</sup> November, 2006 in Malta, made or caused to be made a false return, false statement or false representation and/or furnished the Principal Immigration Officer with false information, and this in violation of Article 32(1)(c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen the consent of the attorney general in terms of art 370 (4) of Chapter 9 of the laws of Malta for this case to be tried summarily and the non objection of the accused for the same procedure;

Having heard the plea of guilt;

Having seen the records of the case;

Finds the accused guitly of all charges;

Having seen articles 4, 5 and 6 of Chapter 61, 189 of Chapter 9, and 32 (1) (c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta;

Condemns the accused to a term of imprisonment of one (1) year from today of which fifteen days shall be effective imprisonment and the rest shall not elapse unless the accused commits any other offence punishable with imprisonment within a term of two years from today in terms of article 28A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

The Court explained the obligations of the accused arising out of this judgement.
