THE COURT

Having seen the charges brought against the accused with having on the 13th of June 2007 on these Islands at about 19.20hours wilfully committed any spoil, damage or injury to, or upon any movable or immovable property, that is on vehicle bearing registration number GMY092 to the detriment of its owner, which such damage exceeds the sum of fifty Maltese liri (LM50.00) but does not exceed the sum of five hundred Maltese liri (LM500.00).

Having seen the consent of the Attorney General for this case to be dealt with summarily.

Having heard the accused declare he has no objection for this case to be dealt with summarily.

Having heard the accused plead guilty as charged;

Finds accused guilty of having on the 13th of June 2007 on these Islands at about 19.20hours wilfully committed any spoil, damage or injury to or upon any movable or immovable property that is on vehicle bearing registration number GMY092 to the detriment of its owner, which such damage exceeds the sum of fifty Maltese liri (LM50.00) but does not exceed the sum of five hundred Maltese liri (LM500.00).

Having seen section 325(1) (b) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

In regard to the punishment to be inflicted; Having considered that the accused obliged himself to pay LM120.00 to complainant as compensation;

Having heard the accused file an early guilty plea;

Instead of the punishment stipulated by law the Court with the application of Article 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta;

Orders that accused be set free on condition he does not commit any further offence within six months from today.

Moreover the Court orders accused to pay complainant the sum of LM120.00.
