## THE POLICE INSPECTOR JOHANN J FENECH

#### **VERSUS**

#### ABDI RAHMAN ABDULLAH HASSAN

#### The Court;

Having seen the charges brought against Abdi Rahman Abdullah Hassan (Police no 02EE-129), aged 29 years, born in Somalia on the 1<sup>st</sup> of July, 1977, son of Abdullah Hassan and Shuri, residing in Block B7, Room 2, Appogg Centre, Hal-Far;

Accused of having on the 5<sup>th</sup> of March, 2007, at the Appogg Open Centre, Hal-Far, at about 03:15am:

1. With arms proper, or with a cutting or pointed instrument, without intent to kill or to put the life

of any person in manifest jeopardy, caused harm to the body of Galaydh Sulayman Ahmed, of Somalian nationality, with bodily harm is deemed to be grievous as it causes any deformity or disfigurement in the face, neck, or either of the hands of the same Galaydh Sulayman Ahmed:

- Also of having committed spoil, damage or injury to or upon any movable or immovable property belonging to any other person, which damages exceed Lm10.00 (ten Maltese pounds), but do not exceed Lm50.00 (fifty Maltese pounds) to the detriment of the Appogg Agency;
- 3. Also of having willfully disturbed the public good order or the public peace;
- 4. Also of having disturbed the repose of the inhabitants by rowdiness or bawling, or in any other manner;
- 5. And finally of also having at the time of committing a crime against a person of Galaydh Sulayman Ahmed, had on his person any arm proper.

Having seen the documents exhibited;

Having heard the evidence produced;

Having seen Articles 216(1)(b), 217, 325(1)(c), 338(dd), 338(m), of Chapter 9 of the Law of Malta, and Article 6 of Chapter 480 of the Laws of Malta.

#### Considers:

This Court finds Abdi Rahman Abdullah Hassan guilty as charged, and condemns him to three (3) months imprisonment, suspended for two (2) years, in terms of Article 28A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.
