**The Court;**

Having seen the charges brought against Ismail Obssa (immigration no 06C 33), aged 26 years, born in Ethiopia in the year 1981, son of Obssa and Mau, residing in Lyster Barracks, Hal-Far;

Accused of having on the 25<sup>th</sup> of July, 2007, at Lyster Barracks, Hal-Far:

1. Reviled, threatened, or caused bodily harm to Gunner C Camilleri 85824, Lance Bombardier C Abdilla 85169, and Gunner N Mangion

85734, persons lawfully charged with a public duty, while in the act of discharging their duty or because of them having discharged such duty, or with intent to intimidate or unduly influence them in the discharge of such duty;

2. Also of having assaulted or resisted by violence or active force not amounting to public violence, Gunner C Camilleri 85824, Lance Bombardier C Abdilla 85169, and Gunner N Mangion 85734, persons lawfully charged with a public duty when in the execution of the Law or of a lawful order issued by a competent authority;

3. Also of having with intent to cause grievous injuries on Gunner Camilleri, manifested his intent by overt acts which were followed by a commencement of the execution of the crime, which crime was not completed in consequence of some accidental cause independent of the will of the offender;

4. Also of having without intent to kill or to put the life of Gunner Camilleri in manifest jeopardy, caused her slight bodily harm, as certified by Dr S Mallia from PHC;

5. And finally also of having willfully disturbed the public good order or the public peace.

Having seen the documents exhibited;

Having heard the evidence produced;

Having seen Articles 95, 96, 41, 216, 221, 338(dd) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

After having seen that the person charged admitted to the charges brought against him.

Considers:

This Court finds Ismail Obssa guilty as charged, and condemns him to three (3) months imprisonment, from
