Kyle Waters, son of Christopher, born in Liverpool, UK and residing in St. Julian's

The Court,

Having seen the charges proffered against the accused that, in these Islands, on the 31st July, 2008 at about 0400 hours, in Trig Wilga, Paceville, St. Julian's –

- 1. without the intent to kill or to put the life of Ryan Fenech in manifest jeopardy caused grievous bodily harm on the person of Ryan Fenech;
- 2. willfully, disturbed the public good order or the public peace.

Informal Copy of Judgement

Having seen the note of the Attorney General whereby he authorized this Court to dispose of this case summarily.

Having seen the records of the case of the 1st August, 2008 from where it results that the accused admitted to the charges as proffered.

Having heard the prosecution and defense counsel for the accused with regard to the punishment to be awarded.

Consequently, this Court finds the accused guilty of the charges as proffered. Having seen sections 214, 216 and 338(dd) of the Criminal Code condemns him to the punishment of two years imprisonment. Having seen section 28A of the Criminal Code orders that this judgement be brought into effect if the accused commits another offence punishable with imprisonment during a period of four years which is to run from today.
