## THE POLICE INSPECTOR SPIRIDIONE ZAMMIT

VS

#### DAVID BRUCE CLARK

#### The Court;

After having seen the charges brought against:

David Bruce Clark of 42 years, son of Patrick and Angela nee' Caplehorn, born in United Kingdom on the 11<sup>th</sup> November 1965, residing at Block G, Flat 4, Qatta Street, Swieqi, holder of Identity Card Number 42807A;

### For Having:

1) on the 7<sup>th</sup> July 2008 by means of any unlawful practice, or by the use of any fictitious name, or the assumption of any false designation, or by means of any other deceit, device or pretence calculated to lead to the belief in the existence of any fictitious enterprise or of any imaginary power, influence or credit, or to create to the expectation or apprehension of any chimerical event, made gain for the sum of

€ 1712.53 to the prejudice of Mario Formosa from Paola.

2) also for having on the same date, time, place and circumstances made gain to the prejudice of Mario Formosa from Paola, a fraudulent gain of € 1712.53

#### Considers:

After having seen the Articles 308, 309 and 310 1 (b) of Chapter 9 of the Maltese Criminal Code;

After having seen the accused admit the charges brought against him, which admission was confirmed by him after having been given due time to reconsider in accordance with the law;

After having heard that the alleged victim had now reconciled with the accused, and did not wish to press any further charges against him;

After having heard the evidence and the documents exhibited;

After having heard the accused's plea and after having given the time prescribed by Law for the accused to consider his plea, this Court finds the said accused guilty as charged, but discharges him from any punishment on condition that he does not commit another offence within

the period of one year from today, in accordance with the provisions of Article 22 Chapter 446 of the Law of Malta.

The Court explained in clear words the terms of the judgement to the accused.
