The Court;

After seeing the charges brought against:

Opoku Emos Mensah of 32 years, son of Alex and Mary nee' Owusuaa, born in Accra Ghana on the 1st July 1975 and holder of Italian ID card no. AM3123269;

Informal Copy of Judgement

For Having:

1)With having on the 24th December 2008 and/ or the previous days in Malta, forged altered or tempered with a passport/s or used or had in his possession a passport/s which he knew to be forged, altered or tempered with four (4) Italian Passports (travelling Documents) and four (4) Italian Residence Permits.

2) Also charge him with having on the same date and circumstances in Malta, knowingly made use of a forged document being the above mentioned passports and residence permits

3) Also with having on the same date and circumstances in Malta, made use of or attempted to make use of a passport issued to any other person.

Considers:

After having seen Article 189 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta and Articles 5 and 3 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta.

After having seen the accused admit the charges brought against him, which admission was confirmed by him after having been given due time to reconsider in accordance with the law;

After having heard the evidence and the documents exhibited;

After having heard the accused's plea and after having given the time prescribed by Law for the accused to consider his plea, this Court finds the said accused guilty as charged and condemns him to a term of two (2) years imprisonment suspended for four (4) years in accordance with the provisions of Article 28A Chapter 9 of the Law of Malta.

The Court explained in clear words the terms of the judgement to the accused.
