The Police (Inspector Mario Haber) vs Mohammed Sangare, son of Abdallah born in Abidjan on the 10th November, 1980

The Court,

Having seen the charges proffered against the accused, namely –

1. with having on the 18th March, 2009 in these Islands forged, altered or tampered with a passport, identity card and residence permit card respectively or used or had in his possession passports and residence permit cards which he knew to be forged, altered or tampered with, bearing numbers H0953631, AO1430414 and M884501 respectively; Kopja Informali ta' Sentenza

2. with having under the same circumstances counterfeited any seal, stamp or other mark used for sealing, stamping, marking, authenticating or certifying in the name of the Government or of any of the authorities thereof, documents or effects, whether public or private property, or which are under the public guarantee;

3. with having under the same circumstances committed any other kind of forgery, or shall knowingly made use of any other forged document, in the mentioned documents;

4. with having under the same circumstances forged any document or true copy of a document or an entry made in pursuance of this act.

Having seen the note filed by the Attorney General whereby he gave his consent that this case be treated summarily.

Having seen the records of the case of the 1st April, 2009 whereby the accused admitted to the charges as proffered.

Having heard the prosecution and the defence counsel of the accused.

Consequently, the Court finds the accused guilty of the charges as proffered. Having seen sections 172(1)(2), 176 and 189 of the Criminal Code, section 5 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta and section 32(1)(d) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta condemns him to a term of imprisonment of six months.
