Garie Robert Anthony Charles, son of Gary, born in Luton,
England on the 12thMay, 1983

The Court,
Having seen the charges proffered against the accused,
namely:

1. that on the 12th January, 2009 between 9.00 p.m.
and 10.00 p.m., entered premises number 12, Mesdows
Court, Triq l-Alka, St. Paul's Bay from where he
committed a theft of €8 (eight euros), which theft is

aggravated by means, by place and by time to the detriment of Zuati Dimitrov;

2. that on the same date, time and place, with intent to commit a theft of objects, the value of which exceeds €233 but is less than €2,233, manifested such intent by overt acts which were followed by the commencement of the execution of the crime, which crime was not completed due to some accidental cause independent of his will, which attempted theft is aggravated by means, by amount, by time and place to the detriment of the said Zuati Dimitrov.

Having seen the noted filed by the Attorney General whereby he gave his consent that this case be tried summarily.

Having seen the records of the case of the 13th January, 2009 from where it results that the accused admitted to the charges as proffered.

Consequently, this Court finds the accused guilty of the charges as proffered. Having seen sections 261(b)(c)(e)(f), 263, 267, 269, 270, 278(1)(2)(3) and 41 of the Criminal Code condemns the accused to a period of imprisonment of one year. Having seen section 28A of the Criminal Code orders that this judgement shall not take effect for a period of one year unless the accused commits another offence punishable with imprisonment during this period of one year.
